

# Building Trades Employers' Association (BTEA) Scholarship Program

## THE PROGRAM

The Thomas S. Gunning Foundation has established a scholarship program to assist students enrolled in the Wentworth Institute of Technology Program through the New England Regional Council of Carpenters.

## ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the Thomas S. Gunning Foundation Scholarship Program must be:

- Enrolled in the Wentworth Institute of Technology Program through the New England Regional Council of Carpenters
- Proof of past employment with a signatory contractor

## AWARDS

One scholarship will be awarded this year in the amount of \$1,000. Payment is made in September and a check will be mailed to the scholarship winner.

## APPLICATION

Interested applicants must complete the attached application *in full* and mail it along with a copy of current grades to the BTEA postmarked no later than June 30, 2019. Application may be reproduced as needed.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. All information received is considered confidential.

## SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, potential to succeed, leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, a statement of educational and career goals, and an outside appraisal.

Final selection of recipient is made by the Board of Trustees of The Foundation. Award recipient will be notified by September 1st. Not all applicants to the program will be selected.

## REVISIONS

The Thomas S. Gunning Foundation reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
